HOWARD PATRICK WOODS, 95, formerly of Palestine, went home to be with the Lord on June 14, 2024, in Tyler, Texas. Howard retired from AT&T (Dallas area) after 40+ years of dedicated service, at the age of 57.

Born to Irvin Miller Woods and Iva Orvetta Cates Woods on July 24, 1928, in Marshall, Texas, he was preceded in death by his parents, seven (7) siblings, his wife of 54 years, Clemmie Huff Woods and son Howard Patrick Woods, Jr.

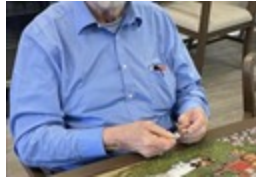
