Jack D. Frizzell, 84, of McKinney, formerly of Tyler, passed away Thursday, Nov. 10, 2016 surrounded by his loving family.

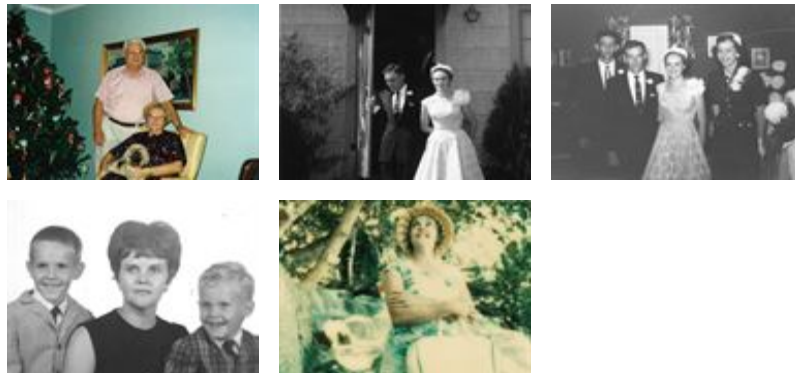
