Jack Payton Stout, 86, of Tyler passed away on June 1, 2019. He was born September 18, 1932 in Glasgow, Kentucky to Louie P. and Jewel Wilson Stout. He graduated from Thomas Jefferson High School in Port Arthur, TX in 1950. After graduation, he joined the Air Force in 1951 and was honorably discharged due to receiving a severe burn. Jack worked as a Journeyman Electrician through IBEW Local Union 479 in Beaumont for more than 40 years, mostly at DuPont in Orange, TX.

Graveside services will be held on Wednesday, June 5, 2019 at 1:00 p.m. at Forest Lawn Memorial Park in Beaumont with Brother Robert Carter officiating under the direction of Stewart Family Funeral Home.

Jack is survived by his wife of 62 1/2 years, Barbara Beck Stout of Tyler; nephew-in-law, Kent Bailey of Port Neches, TX; and niece-in-law, Kay Bailey of Beaumont.

Jack was a member of Colonial Hills Baptist Church in Tyler and the Joy Class, whose members he dearly loved.
