



Jacquelyn Crawford

Memorial services for, Jacquelyn L. Crawford, 65, of Tyler, are scheduled for 2:00 P.M., Sunday, July 10, 2005, at First Christian Church of Tyler with the Rev. Dr. Jeff Wilson officiating and Rev. Ron Byrd assisting. Mrs. Crawford died Friday, July 8, 2005 in a Tyler hospital. She was born to James Sewell and Bonnie Adrian Ferguson Johnson on September 4, 1939 in San Angelo, Texas. Mrs. Crawford lived in the Tyler area since 1970 where she was an insurance professional. She attended San Angelo high school and San Angelo Business College. She was also a member of the Tyler Junior College Phi Theta Kappa honor society. Later she worked in the insurance business for thirty years including a stint with her own agency in Tyler. She was a member and served as an officer of Tyler Insurance Women, the Tyler Women's Forum and served as a member of The Salvation Army auxiliary. Mrs. Crawford was a member and elder of First Christian Church of Tyler and chairwoman of the memorial committee. She was preceded in death by her father James Sewell Johnson in 1973. Survivors include her husband, James 'Jim' G. Crawford of Tyler; mother and step-father, Adrian Crouch and Talley Crouch; two daughters, Kay Gray Adams and Vicki G. Brockette; two sons, Richard L. Gray, Jr., and Jimmy Scott Gray; four step-children, Jim, Carol, Kimberly, and Ken Crawford; seven grandchildren, one great-grandchild; and one brother, Bill Crouch.
