Services for James Manning, 82, of Tyler, beloved husband, father, grandfather, and faithful servant, will be held on Monday, December 17, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. at Green Acres Baptist Church Chapel with Dr. David O. Mr. Manning passed away Thursday, December 13, 2018 in Tulsa, OK. He was born April 1, 1936 in Madisonville to Melvin and Ozelle Manning.

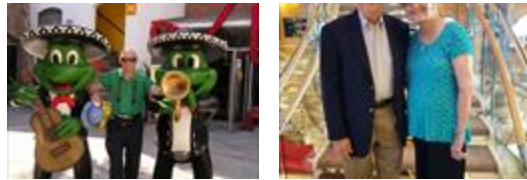
