He joined the US Army in 1965, volunteered for Vietnam in 1971 receiving an honorable discharge as Staff Sergeant E-6, the National Defense Service Medal, the Vietnam Service Medal with 3 Bronze Service Stars, the Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal and the Sharpshooter (rifle). 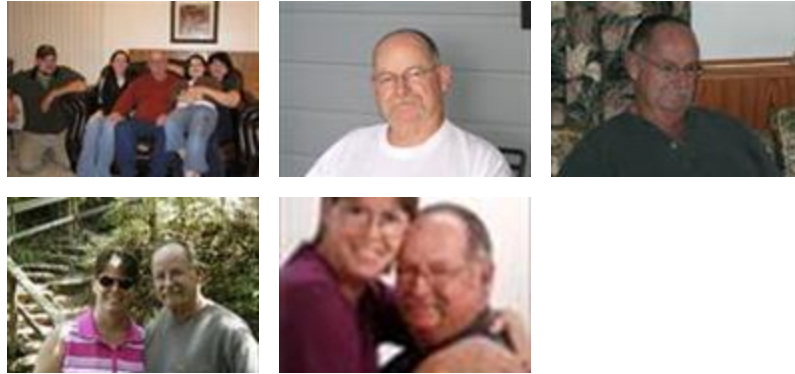
