



## Janet Rippy

January 4, 1937 - July 4, 2024

Janet Oneta Leggett Rippy, 87, of Tyler, Texas went home to be with her Lord and Savior on Thursday, July 4, 2024. She was born January 4, 1937, in Houston, Texas to the late Gwendolyn Harmon and Frank Leon Leggett, and was raised with her older sister Nelda in Sulphur Springs, Texas. In high school she was president of the Spanish Club, vice president of the National Honor Society, elected School Favorite and Western Day Queen. After graduating, Janet continued her education at East Texas State University in Commerce, Texas where she graduated in three years with a teaching degree. On August 31, 1956, Janet married the love of her life, James Hargis Rippy, who was studying to be an engineer. The couple lived in Lubbock, where Janet taught first grade while Jim completed his degree at Texas Tech University. They moved to Midland before settling in Tyler in 1968.

The Rippys joined Marvin Methodist Church, where Janet taught various levels of Sunday School, but she was most remembered for teaching tenth grade. She joined the Junior League of Tyler, the Women's Symphony League and she volunteered for the Texas Rose Festival. She was known to be an excellent bridge player. Janet was well-read and well-versed in many areas, especially the Bible. We all take comfort in knowing with total assurance that Janet is in eternal glory with our Lord. Her deep faith in Christ gave her strength, peace, and joy throughout her life.

Janet was preceded in death by her loving husband of 55 years, James H. (Jim) Rippy, her sister Nelda Wilson Brownlee, as well as her parents.
