



## Jean Fred Beam

September 3, 1958 - January 1, 2013

Services for Jean Fred Beam, 54, of Tyler, will be held on Friday, January 4, 2013, at 1:30 PM at Green Acres Baptist Church with Rev. Ken Brumley officiating.

Mr. Beam passed away Tuesday, January 1, 2013 at Mother Francis Hospital. He was born September 3, 1958, in Great Lakes, Illinois to Clarence and Irmgard Lupus Beam.

Fred was a longtime member of Green Acres Baptist Church and was a director in Potter's Cast Drama Ministries of the Church.

Mr. Beam moved to Tyler in 1971 and graduated from John Tyler High School and received his Bachelor's degree from the University of Texas at Tyler.

Fred worked for Payless Cashways as a Manager for many years before he found his calling as an Audioprosthologist in 2001 and spent the last several years with the ENT Associates of East Texas.
