Memorial services for Jeffrey Allen Lee, 44, Tyler, are scheduled for Monday, September 10, 2007 at 10:00 AM at Pollard United Methodist Church, 3030 New Copeland Road in Tyler, Texas with Rev. Visitation for family and friends is scheduled for Sunday, September 9, 2007 from 6:00-8:00 PM at the funeral home. Mr. Lee died September 6, 2007 in Tyler. He was born November 15, 1962, in Memphis, Tennessee, to James and Shirley Lee. He grew up in Henderson and graduated from Henderson High School in 1981 and attended Kilgore College. Jeff's early career included music as owner and bass guitarist with Southern Wind, a country band that played throughout Texas, and the Southwest; a radio personality at KYNG - Young Country, and a producer with Bayou Sound Company. After returning to Tyler he worked as an optician with Ragsdale and Martin Optical and Eye Care Associates. Jeff is a member of Pollard United Methodist Church. Jeff was preceded in death by grandparents J.B. and Stannie Lee and W.C. and Leola McElroy. Survivors include son, Jacob Lee, of Bullard; parents, Dr. James and Shirley Lee of Tyler; brothers and sisters-in-law, Greg and Jolene Lee, John and Leigh Lee, and Robert and Janice Lee, and several nieces, nephews, aunts, uncles and cousins.
