



Lt. Col. Jerry D. Belobraydic

May 23, 1944 - July 6, 2018

A requiem mass for Lt. Col. Jerry D. Belobraydic, 74, of Tyler, will be held on Friday, July 13, 2018 at 10:30 a.m. at St. Mary Magdalene Catholic Church with Rev. James Rowland, Rev. Timothy Kelly, and Msgr. John Flynn officiating. A graveside service will be held Tuesday, July 17, 2018 at 1:30 p.m. at the Kentucky Veterans Cemetery Central in Radcliff, Kentucky under the direction of Stewart Family Funeral Home.

Mr. Belobraydic passed away Friday, July 06, 2018 in Tyler. He was born May 23, 1944 in East St. Louis, Illinois to Emil Matthew Belobraydic and Virginia Johnson Belobraydic. Jerry was preceded in death by his parents and his brother, Michael James Belobraydic.

Jerry was a member of St. Mary Magdalene Catholic Church, Knights of Columbus, The Rotary Club of Tyler, MOAA, GTOAA, Corvettes of Tyler, and Numerous Car Clubs. He graduated from Webster College in Saint Louis, Missouri with a Master of Arts. He was a Vietnam Veteran, who retired from the United States Army after serving 26 years.
