Jerry Lynn Moore, age 55, went to be with the His Lord on July 5, 2007 at Hospice of East Texas in Tyler, following a 6 year strong and courageous battle with cancer. A celebration of Jerry's life will be held Monday, July 9, 2007, at 2:00 pm at the Chapel of Green Acres Baptist Church with John Beard and Stuart Sumrall officiating. Burial will follow at Cathedral in the Pines under the direction of Stewart Family Funeral Home. Jerry was born in Dallas on June 16, 1952 to Carl and Faye Moore. He graduated from Richardson High School in 1970 and The University of Texas at Austin in 1974 with a major in Business. Jerry and his devoted wife, Chris, were married June 28, 1974, having just celebrated 33 years of marriage the day he entered Hospice. Jerry's greatest joy was his family. His life as a proud father began March 19, 1978 with the birth of his daughter, Randee and the birth of his son, Jayme, on November 16, 1981. His life was made complete with the birth of his two precious granddaughters, Karlyee Christine and Emma Jerilynne, who affectionately called him Poppie. Following graduation from UT, Jerry was employed by King Fennell and later by Federated Foods as Brookshire's Hy-Top representative. He joined Brookshire Grocery Company in 1982 serving as grocery merchandiser, a grocery buyer, and later as a General Merchandise Category Manager. And no matter how he felt he will always be remembered there for his positive attitude and whistling while he walked down the halls. Anyone who knew Jerry knew he was an avid sports enthusiast and a loyal Texas Longhorn fan. One of the highlights of his life was his

opportunity, along with his son, to attend and see his Longhorns win the Rose Bowl in 2006.
