Jim (Jimmie) Hoyette Parker, 81, passed away peacefully on April 18, 2026, surrounded by his family. He was born on August 24, 1944, via a Home Birth, in Anson, Texas, to Brooksie and James Parker, both of whom preceded him in death. He was also preceded in death by his brother Kenneth D Parker.

Jim is survived by his loving wife of 36 years, Karen Kay Parker. also had a deep love for the outdoors and could often be found golfing, fishing, hunting or simply enjoying nature. He built 2 homes in his lifetime, with the latest being the home he built for him and Karen after retirement on Lake Fork. He enjoyed having all of his grandchildren come to their home for 'grandparent week'; he taught them how to ride bikes on their long driveway, caught them in the pool a million times and had little helpers picking up sticks in the yard to make a fire for smores. We believe being named "Papa" by his grandchildren was one of his favorite nicknames.
