April 12, 1928 - April 24, 2006

Jimmie Martin (Jim) Procell, age 78, passed from this life on April 24, 2006 in Tyler, Texas and is now resting in peace with our Lord Jesus Christ. Jim was born on April 12, 1928 in a Boxcar at the foot of Mile High Hill in Northern Sabine County. Jim graduated from Hemphill High School in 1946 as President of his class, class favorite, and most likely to succeed. He was a graduate of Tyler Commercial College and the University of Texas in Austin, and attained a BBA in 3 years in the field of Insurance. Jim was also a member of the US Army with service in Germany. He did several things during his life including washing dishes, logging, welding, carpentry, Funeral Director, and Insurance Examiner for the State. He began working at Combined Underwriters Life Insurance Company in 1960 where he was an Agent, Vice President, President, and eventually Vice Chairman until he retired in 2002. Jim was a member and past President of the Cedars of Lebanon Club, member and past President of the Optimist Club, was on the Tyler Catholic School Board, the Church Finance Committee, honorary initiated member of the Sigma Phi Epsilon Fraternity, and was a 4th Degree Knights of Columbus. He was preceded in death by his parents, Pete and Rosie Lee Hatchl Procell, and brother, Peter Procell.
