On March 31, 2023, Jon Jasper, beloved husband, Daddy and Poppie, passed away at the age of 75 at The Hospice of East Texas HomePlace. He was born August 17, 1947, in Decatur, Indiana to Hubert and Opal (Williams) Jasper. He grew up in Kentucky where he graduated from Clark County High School and then received his chemical engineering degree from University of Kentucky. He was a lifelong UK Wildcat fan and a proud alumnus. Upon graduation from college, Jon and his wife of 53 years, Susan (Elam) Jasper, moved to Texas where he began his career in the oil and gas industry and they raised their children, Carrie-Ann, Jane E. and Brent.
