We often had lunch together and spent many hours huddled in hallways and conference rooms working out the next big idea but the conversation almost always came back to family. His whole demeanor change as he talked about you and the boys. His pride in

your promotion or your son's acceptance to Moore was just bursting from him. His description of his Christmas ritual for the boys was fabulous and made me wish I had been half as dedicated to Colin's experience! And he was giddy when he described getting the boys the Wii or watching them play. I could go on and on...

I know there is nothing that can be done or said at this time to ease the pain but you can take some comfort in knowing how very much he loved you all and that he always will.
