Services for Joseph Franklin Odom, 86, of Tyler will be held on Thursday, May 8, 2025, at 10:30 a.m. at The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in Bullard with President Charles Rhodus presiding. Joe passed away Thursday, May 1, 2025, in Tyler. He was born October 4, 1938, in Pensacola, FL to Herman Wesley Odom Sr. and Violet Anna Hale Odom.

Joe was a member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints and served faithfully in numerous callings throughout his life. 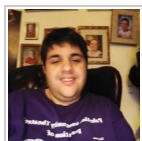
