Mr. Sheehy passed away Sunday, October 5, 2025, in Tyler. He was born December 27, 1940, in Tyler to Joseph Warren Sheehy and Mable Putman Sheehy. Along with practicing law he served on many boards throughout the years. He joined the Southside State Bank Board in 1982, serving over 41 years. He retired from the board May 2023. He was then elected as Director of Emeritus January 1, 2024. He also served as the Risk Committee Chair for over six years. He served on Tyler Planning &

Zoning board, & the Tyler Appraisal & Review board.

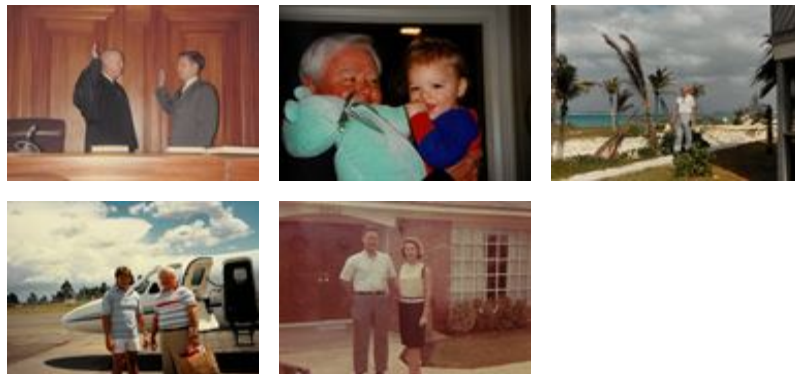

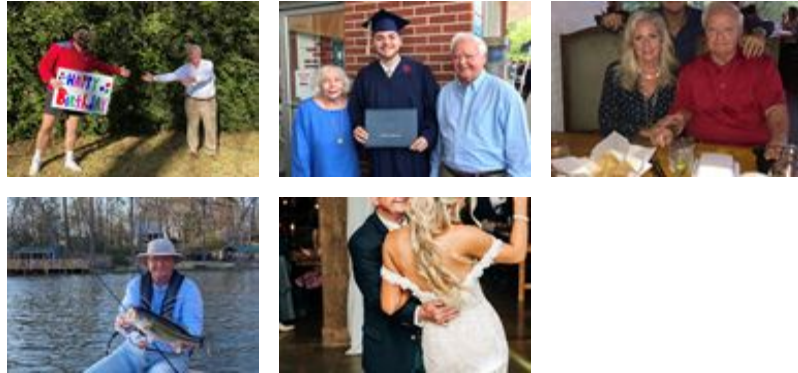
