Justin passed away peacefully on Friday, July 10, 2020 after a courageous battle with cancer. He was born July 3, 1975 in Alameda, California to Jerry and Deborah Adams.

Justin graduated from Alameda High School in Alameda, California in 1993. He went on to graduate with a Bachelor's Degree in History from University of the Pacific in Stockton, California, where he was a member of Phi Alpha Theta National Honor Society.
