A private graveside service for Kay Hunt Dawson, of Tyler will be held at Cathedral in the Pines Cemetery in Tyler with Rev. Ron Wells officiating.

Kay passed away Monday, October 16, 2023, in Tyler. She was born August 5, 1948, in Tyler to Mary Lavillas Yowell and Tillman D. Hunt.

Kay was a member of Green Acres Baptist Church, Women's Symphony League, Quairo Literary Club, and the TJC President's Circle. She was a former Board Member of Centrepoin Ministry and Former President of Baylor Women's Council of Tyler. She was a graduate of Robert E Lee High School and then attended the University of Texas at Austin before graduating from Baylor University, with a Bachelor of Arts in English. She was selected to be a member of the Alpha Chi Honor Society, based on her scholastic achievements. Kay received a Master's in Education from the University of Texas at Tyler in 1981 and joined the TJC staff teaching English and Leadership Development.

Kay's love of family was exemplified by the joy she took in the lives of her children and her three granddaughters. She was a fiercely devoted mother and grandmother and a loyal friend. She loved to travel and was a voracious reader. She left a deep imprint on the lives of those closest to her.
