Kenneth Harold Culpepper, 74, was called to his Heavenly home on July 12, 2018 in Tyler, Texas. 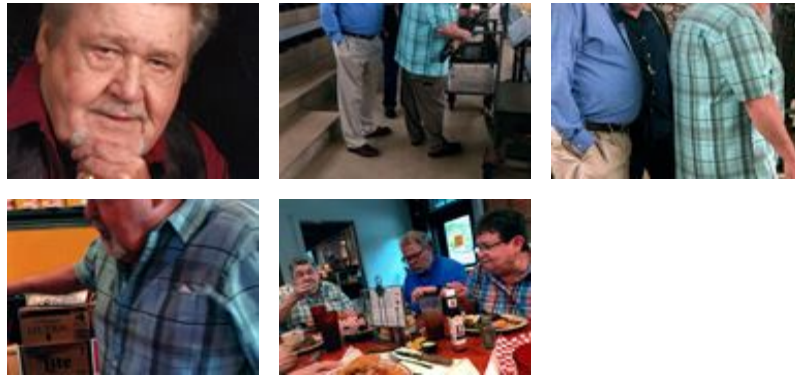
