Landon passed away Friday, March 27, 2020 in Troup. He was born March 22, 2004 in Tyler. His parents are Mark R. Layne and Cheryl D. Layne.

Landon attended Green Acres Baptist Church for the majority of his life and made many friends there. He was a sophomore at Whitehouse High School and was on the cross-country team. He enjoyed photography, car DJing for his sister, snow-skiing and Xbox marathons.

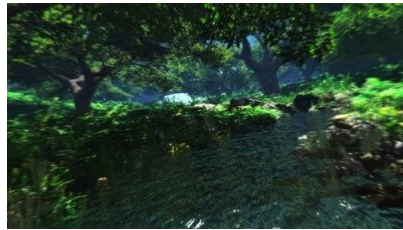

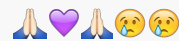

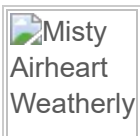
