



## Larry DeVasto

February 16, 1948 - August 17, 2012

A Memorial service for Larry DeVasto, 64 of Tyler will be held on Friday, August 24, 2012 at 2:00 PM at Stewart Family Funeral Home Chapel, 7525 Old Jacksonville Highway in Tyler. Larry passed away at the Hospice of East Texas on Friday, August 17, 2012, after a brief illness. He was born February 16, 1948 in Bronx, New York to Frank and Bettejane Devasto.

Frank and his family moved to Abilene in 1957, where Larry graduated from Abilene Cooper High School in 1966. Larry later attended McMurry University, receiving a degree in English.
