Larry Frowick, 61, passed from this life into the loving arms of his Lord and Savior on September 22, 2024, in Tyler, Texas after a courageous and hard fought battle with pancreatic cancer and was reunited with his parents Lloyd and Caroline (Hintz) Frowick.

Larry was born in Germany on October 24, 1962. While in Germany, his brother Gary was born. The family moved to the states where his second brother Jerry was born. The 3 boys grew up in Norfolk, Nebraska and as you can imagine, being 11 and 15 months apart, the “trouble” they got into.

Larry graduated from Norfolk High School in 1981. He attended Northeast Technical Community College in Norfolk and obtained an Associates degree in Data Processing and Computer Programming. Shortly thereafter, he moved to Florida where he met the love of his life, Lisa, in Ft. Myers while working at a banking data processing center. They married on June 27, 1987 at St. Micheal Lutheran Church in Ft. Myers.

They moved “back” to Texas since Lisa was born in Nacogdoches and chose to reside in Tyler as it seemed to be the perfect place to raise a family. They became members of Trinity Lutheran Church and shortly after, were blessed with two wonderful sons, Cameron and Brandon.

Larry gave his heart to many organizations throughout his life. While at Trinity, he was involved with Sunday School youth group, Life Groups and served as an elder for over 20 years. More recently, Larry was a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church Disaster Response Team. They have helped many communities in multiple states devastated by severe weather. This is a perfect example of his servant's heart!

His two sons became involved in Boy Scouts where Larry served in many roles. He was a mentor/father to many scouts along the way. Campouts, summer camp trips, merit badge instruction and National Jamboree were memories that were very dear to him. He earned the Triple Crown of High Adventure Scouting by attending Northern Tier High Adventure, Philmont Scout Ranch and Sea Base High Adventure Camp. The biggest joy was when both of his sons received the rank of Eagle Scout.

He was a lover of the outdoors and instilled this into his boys. There were numerous camping, fishing and hunting trips over the years. He was also an avid traveler to places like state and national parks and many countries all over the world!

He retired from Christus Health where he worked in Information Technology for over 20 years. His new role of being a "Gpa" was his new priority. Larry was blessed with two grandsons who love the outdoors just as much as he did. They enjoyed riding the Ranger, going to the zoo and sitting in his lap reading books.

He is survived by his loving family including his wife, Lisa; son, Cameron and wife Meredith with grandson Stetson; son, Brandon and wife Amanda with grandson Gabriel; brother, Gary and wife Kim; brother, Jerry; his in-laws Marshall and Carol Treadwell; along with numerous nephews, nieces, aunts and uncles.
