Larry was born January 4, 1950 to the late Carroll and Sarah Parrish Lee in Silsbee, Texas. He was raised in Marshall where he graduated from Marshall High School in 1968. In 1969, he married Laura Crawford before entering the Army where he was stationed in Korea during the Vietnam War and was honorably discharged in 1972. After the war, Larry moved to Pittsburg, TX and New Orleans, LA and settled in Tyler in 1975. Mr. Lee was a member of Central Baptist Church and worked as an x-ray technician for 25 years at East Texas Medical Center. He was working with Davita, Inc. until his death. He enjoyed collecting guns, knives and flashlights. Larry will always be remembered as a devoted family man who loved music, his dogs and riding motorcycles. He was preceded in death by his parents. Mr. Lee is survived by his loving family including his wife of 37 years, Laura Crawford Lee; daughters Misty Kimble and husband Jim, of Maryland; Leslie Kittrell and husband, Andrew, of Flint; grandchildren Faith Lee, Erica Kimble, Jack Kimble and Dawson Kittrell; his brother, Randy Lee and wife, Barbara of Arkansas; and two nephews Joshua Lee and Jared Lee.
