Larry was a member of Christ Episcopal Church. He attended St. John Military School in Salina, KS and then went on to graduate from high school in Mamaroneck, NY. He was a member of Kappa Sigma Fraternity at the University of Oklahoma where he graduated in petroleum engineering. He served 2 years in the Army Corps of Engineers from 1956-1958. He worked for Schlumberger Well Services for 24 years and then finished his working career with Triangle Springs. After retirement, he enjoyed spending many a day at his tree farm, and maintaining beautiful landscaping at his home. After leaving the tree farm, Larry became a maker of walking canes, carving each one individually with his own hands.
