Lin Trenton Barker, age 83, of Tyler, Texas, passed away peacefully on May 16, 2026, with family at his bedside.

He was born on June 9, 1942, in Westville, Florida. He was the eighth of ten children born to Bunk and Ethel Barker. From an early age, he learned the values of hard work, integrity, faith, and caring for others — values that remained the foundation of his life.

Coming from a large family created lifelong bonds that he treasured deeply. Lin shared fifty-six wonderful years of marriage with his late wife, Sandra “Sandy” Lee Barker, and later found companionship and happiness with his wife, Laura Hyde Barker.

He is survived by his sons, David and Lisa Barker of Longview and Craig Barker of Bullard; his grandchildren Marley Barker, Matt and Kaytlin Barker, Lawson and Rachel Barker, and Mason Barker; and his stepsons Todd and Kim Hyde of Tyler and Trevor and Jennifer Hyde of Kerrville.

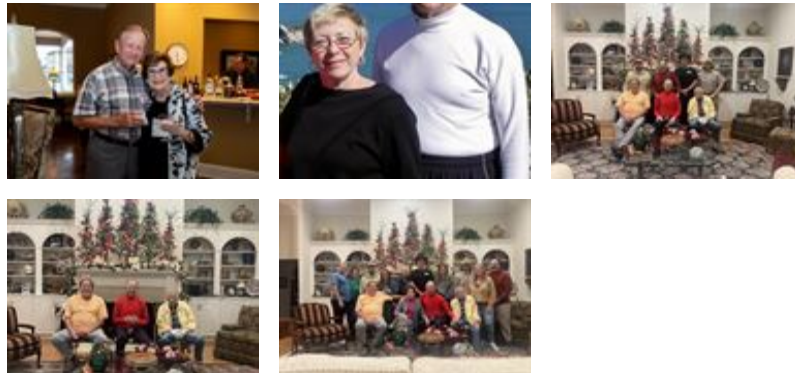
