She was a fantastic Southern cook, she was a regular East Texas Martha Stewart and she loved Southern Living, antiquing, traveling and cooking a Thanksgiving and Christmas Day meal that would feed an army! 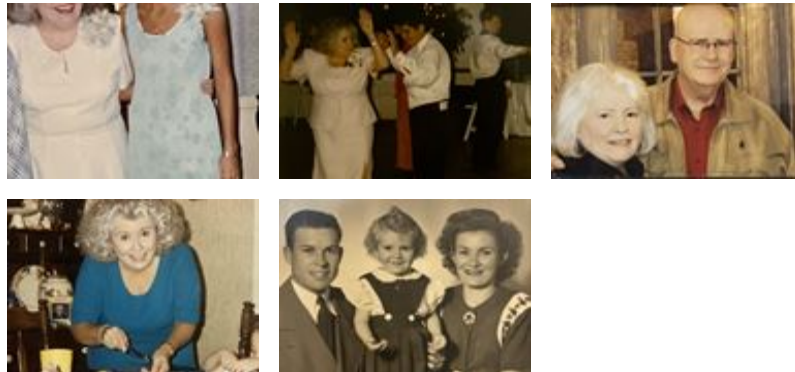
