Lloyd Stephen (Steve) Shipp, 77, passed away unexpectedly on Saturday, April 20, 2013. Steve was born on July 18, 1935, in Beeville, Texas to R. E. & Florence Shipp. He grew up in the oil fields of Iraan, Texas, attended Schreiner College for his freshman year, graduated from the University of Texas with a bachelor of science degree in Pharmacy in 1959, and was honored for remaining active in the profession for over 50 years.
