



## Loring Mathew (Bubba) Ashby

April 5, 1940 - June 12, 2017

A memorial service will be held for Loring Mathew (Bubba) Ashby at Stewart Funeral Home in Tyler, at 2:00 p.m., on Wednesday, June 14, 2017, with Rev. Gerry Giles officiating. Visitation will be one hour prior to service at 1:00 p.m.. Bubba died on Monday, June 12, 2017.

Loring was born in Henderson, Texas, in 1940, the youngest child of Joe Criss and Olive Williams Ashby. He was a 1958 graduate of Henderson High School, and shortly after graduation, joined the National Guard, doing his basic training in Ft. Ard, California. His unit was called to active duty during the Berlin Crisis in 1963, and he spent over a year at Ft. Polk, Louisiana. He was honorable discharged from the army on April 30, 1965.

Bubba worked at Eastman Chemical Company, a division of Texas Eastman, in Longview, for over 30 years. He retired in 1998. He and his wife moved from Henderson to Tyler in 2004. They are members of Marvin United Methodist Church.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his brother John Neil Ashby, his sister Sammie Ashby Skeen, and two nephews. He is survived by his wife Linda Moseley Ashby; they celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary, in July, 2016. He is also survived by brother-in-law and sister-in-law, Billy and Margaret Moseley, sister-in-law Paula Ashby, all of Henderson, and a number of cousins, nieces, and nephews.

A private burial service will be held at the Bascom Memorial Cemetery under the direction of Stewart Funeral Home.
