Luke Joseph Geoffrion, 80, passed away on November 23, 2025. He was born in Waltham, Massachusetts, and made Tyler, Texas his home for 18 years before moving to Fort Worth, TX, where he built a life rooted in love, dedication, and joyful moments with family.

Luke proudly served his country as a member of the United States Navy, he served in the Vietnam War as a Naval Lieutenant flying C-2A Greyhounds, stationed in Japan, Philippines, and San Diego, a commitment that shaped his character and sense of duty. Following his military service, he pursued a distinguished career in aviation, retiring as a Captain for US Airways. His love for flying matched his steady, disciplined nature, adventurous spirit—and his genuine passion for connecting with people.

Above all, Luke was a devoted husband, father, and grandfather. He was preceded in death by his parents, Lucian and Dorothy Geoffrion; his older brother, Robert; and his granddaughter, Kaitlin. He is survived by his loving wife, Kathy Geoffrion; his children—Scott (Houston, TX), Danielle (Houston, TX), Tracy (Durham, NC), Brandon (Tyler, TX), and Carrie (Fort Worth, TX); and six cherished grandchildren who brought immense joy and pride to his life.

Luke will be remembered for his fun, loving, and playful spirit, as well as his

unwavering work ethic. He was always up to something—fixing, tinkering, rearranging, or overseeing a project that may or may not have actually needed doing. And when he wasn't hard at work, he was equally committed to his other great talent: taking a perfectly timed nap, anywhere, anytime. He loved spending time with his family—whether relaxing at the beach, enjoying the lake, playing games or sharing stories and laughter with those he loved.

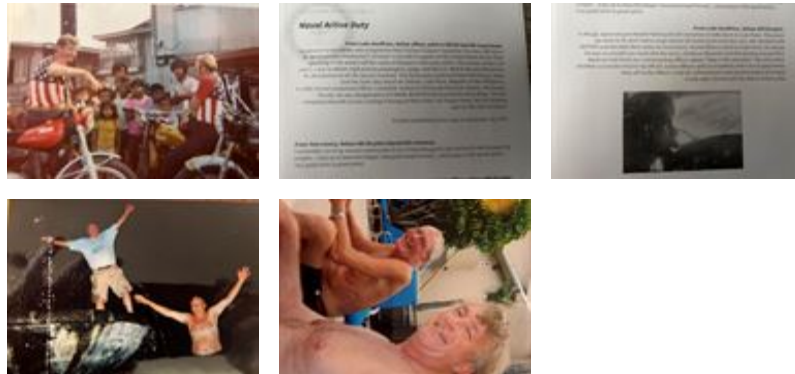
