She then attended Decatur Baptist College and then went on to Howard Payne University where she received a degree in business. She taught in Hurst, Alba-Golden, and Franklin and finished her last 22 years teaching at Rice Elementary. Anne was also a 20 year volunteer at ETMC. She supported her husband in six pastorates: Alba, Franklin, Flint, Big Sandy, County Line, and Golden. She was devoted to Christian Ministry her entire life, particularly working with church youth programs. She was preceded in death by her parents and her eight siblings. Anne is survived by her loving family including her husband of 63 years, Rev. Edwin Lewis of Tyler; sons, Philip Lewis and wife Denita of San Antonio and Barry Lewis and wife Melinda of Irving; grandchildren, Shane Lewis and wife Kari of Trophy Club, Lane Lewis of San
