Margaret Ruth Irby passed away on Tuesday October 11, 2016 with her family by her side in Houston Texas. 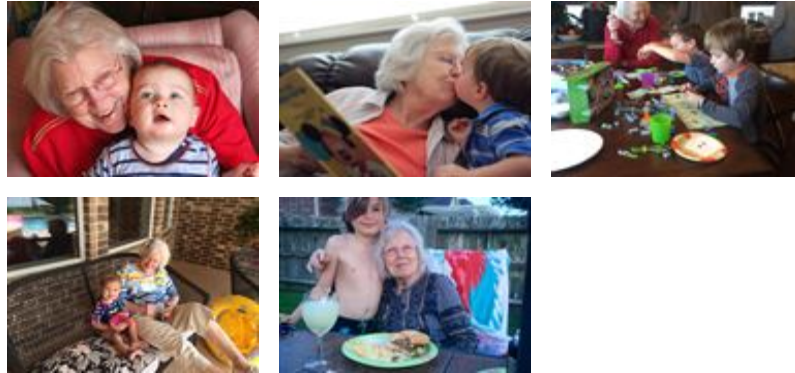
