Mrs. Sanders was a charter member of Friends of Devereux, a non-profit organization specializing in the treatment of children with emotional and developmental problems. Mrs. Sanders graduated from high school in Idabel in 1938 and received a BA in Education from Oklahoma State in 1942 and then a MA in Education from the University of Houston in 1961. She was employed as a school teacher by Pasadena Independent School District and retired in May of 1985 after 38 years of service. She was extremely active during her 24 years of retirement. She loved to travel and was very involved with her church and various community service activities.
