



## Margie Huff Plunk

Memorial services for Margie Dell Huff Plunk, 96, of Lindale will be held on Saturday, October 28, 2023, at 1:30 p.m. at Stewart Family Funeral Home in Tyler, TX with grandson Jeffrey Muffoletto officiating. Margie, also affectionately known as Mom and Mamaw, passed away Wednesday, October 18, 2023, in Beaumont. She was born May 3, 1927, in Mineola to Sam and Gladys Snyder Huff.

Margie was a member of Lindale Church of Christ but was a long-time member of Rice Rd. Church of Christ which was formerly Garden Valley Rd Church of Christ in Tyler, TX. Along with her husband, J.D., they helped start the Garden Valley Rd. congregation in the 1960s.

She graduated from Mineola HS in 1944. She worked in many different occupations throughout her life and retired from East Texas Savings and Loan as a loan processor. Her greatest job and the one she took the most pride in, was being a wife, mom, grandmother, and homemaker.

Margie was preceded in death by her first husband, J.D. Plunk after 50 years of marriage. She then married Clifford W. Maclin who preceded her in death

after 20 years of marriage. She is also preceded in death by her son-in-law, Frankie Muffoletto. She is survived by her loving family including sons, Larry Plunk and wife Johnna, Kenneth Plunk and wife Norma; and daughter, Kelly Muffoletto. She had 5 grandsons; 1 granddaughter; 10 great-grandsons; and 1 great-granddaughter.
