Marilyn Sue Hill, our beloved mother, grandmother, sister, aunt, and friend passed away March 6, 2011 in Tyler, Texas. She was 61 years old. Susie was born in Tyler, Texas on July 26, 1949. She was the daughter of Robert Bryant Maynard, Sr. and Rose Ann Maynard. She graduated from Tyler Catholic High School in 1967 and was homecoming queen her senior year. Susie attended Tyler Junior College, Stephen F. Austin State University, and graduated from North Texas State University in 1973 with a Bachelor of Arts in English. Susie's name has been synonymous with doing for others for over 40 years. Susie was a volunteer for the American Red Cross, YMCA, Smith County Association for Retarded Citizens, PTA, and Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts of America. Susie dedicated her professional life to building safe families, loving relationships, protecting the rights of women and children, and teaching life skills to countless people. Susie served her community by working at the East Texas Crisis Center, Parents Anonymous of Tyler, The Andrews Center, The Autism Services Center in Huntington, West Virginia, and most recently Metrocrest Social Services in Carrollton, Texas. Active socially and politically, Susie was a member of the League of Women Voters, served as a delegate to several Democratic State Conventions as well as the 1980 Democratic National Convention. Her work and her love for others will live on in the lives that she has touched and through the people she has helped. Her personal philosophy in life was "You only live one life here on earth – Do all you can while you can". Susie was preceded in death by her husband, Ronald P. Hill.
