



## Maxine Dobbs Fisher

February 17, 1942 - October 12, 2023

Funeral services for Maxine Dobbs Fisher, 81, of Tyler, Texas will be held at 2:00 p.m., Thursday, October 26, 2023, at Stewart Family Funeral Home, with the Rev. Robert Carter and the Rev. Jason White officiating. Interment will follow the service at Rose Lawn Cemetery.

Mrs. Fisher went home to be with her Lord and Savior on October 12, 2023, after a brief illness. She was born February 17, 1942, in the country town of Welch, Oklahoma near Miami, Oklahoma to J. Paul and Nina Dobbs.

Maxine graduated from Miami High School in 1960 and attended North Eastern Oklahoma A&M College before moving to Dallas to work as a bookkeeper and accountant for the Trammel Crow Co.

In 1969 Maxine married Ted Fisher whom she had met and enjoyed sharing classes with while both were students at N.E.O. College in 1963-1964. They enjoyed 54 years of marriage while living in Austin and then Tyler, Texas.

While living in Austin, Maxine was the executive secretary and office manager for the Texas Music Teachers Association. After moving to Tyler she was employed as Finance-office manager at Colonial Hills Baptist Church for 13 years until her retirement in 2017.

Maxine is survived by her husband Ted and two sons, Jeffrey Fisher and his wife Marsha of Apex, North Carolina and Jason Fisher of Houston, Texas. Also surviving are grandsons, Caleb Fisher and wife Ambar of Raleigh, North Carolina; Noah Fisher of Apex, North Carolina; and brother J. Melvin Dobbs and wife Deborah of Roanoke, Virginia.
