She went on to attend Paris Beauty School and became a licensed beautician before she furthered her education at the Texas Technology Institute in Fort Worth with a focus on Computer Science. She was diagnosed with Lupus at the young age of 16. She worked for the Environmental Protection Agency in Dallas as an Inventory Control Specialist and enjoyed her work and all the life long friends she made over the years. Missy's passion in life was her dogs and playing Bingo, and her family will always remember her as a down to Earth and genuine person with a natural ability to "Love Life."
