No matter who we are...”*

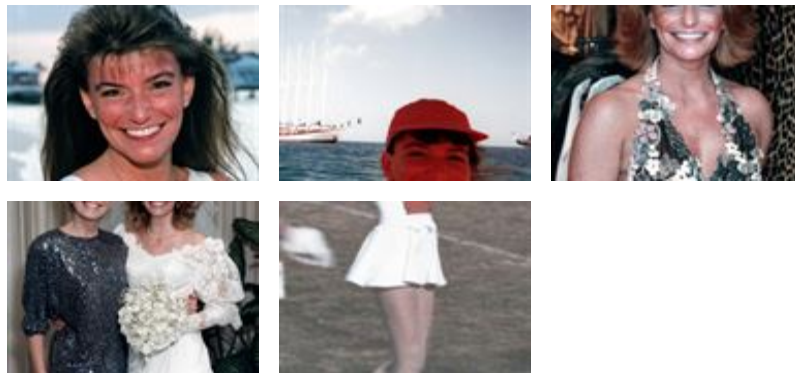
