January 16, 1936 - October 11, 2017

Mr. Duncan passed away Wednesday, October 11, 2017 in Tyler.

He was born January 16, 1936 in Cayuga to Aubrey Alvin, Sr. and Nell Conard Duncan.

Ned was part owner of Massey and Brown Sporting Goods Store. He was a fast-pitch softball legend, an All American basketball player at Kilgore College when it won a national championship and SMU, when SMU won the Southwest Conference title. Ned was inducted into the NJCAA Basketball Hall of Fame, along with the Kilgore College Hall of Fame. He was a member of the Cayuga Wildcat team that won three high school Championship basketball titles. Ned was also an avid golfer and fisherman.

He was preceded in death by his parents.
