Pamela “Pam” Sue Stanley VanScoder, daughter, caring wife, loving mother and proud Granny left this world suddenly, early in the morning of February 3, 2023. After a courageous battle with cancer and heart failure, at the age of 68, she went to be in Heaven.

She was born, May 19, 1954 in Trenton, MO to Wayne M. Stanley and Minnie F. Atchley Stanley. Pam moved from Missouri to Iowa to Oklahoma as her Dad worked on the railroad. 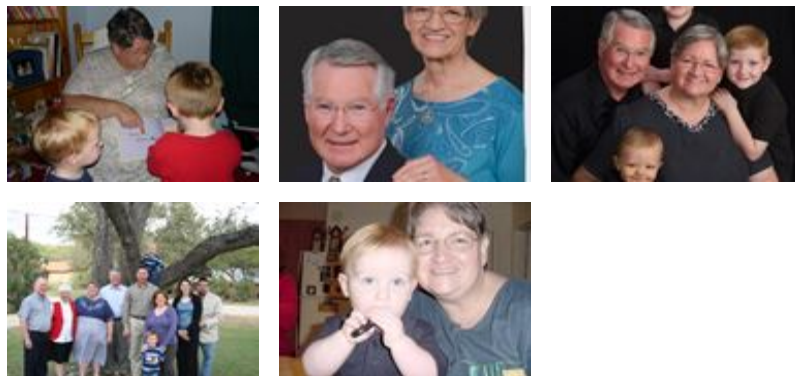
