May 21, 1950 - September 9, 2024

Patricia M. Akstin of Tyler, Texas unexpectedly passed away on the morning of September 9th, 2024. Patricia was born May 21, 1950 in Boston, MA, second daughter of Gordon V. Peacock and Edith M. (Clark) Peacock. She was raised in Cohasset, MA, graduating from Centenary College for Women, Hackettstown, NJ in 1970. She embarked on a retail career at Filene's Department Store, downtown Boston as a shoe buyer. Shortly after, she met her future husband, Anthony C (Chuck) Akstin and they were married in Cohasset on October 2, 1971. The newlyweds began a Marine Corps military career with assignments in North Carolina, Virginia, Washington, DC , and Hawaii. Upon Chuck's retirement, the family settled in Alexandria, VA, where Patricia became a vice president of an IT company in southern Maryland. In 2006, the Akstin's retired to Southport, NC then in 2021, Tyler, TX.

Patricia was preceded in death by her loving son, Christopher. She is survived by her sister, Valerie Sizemore of Monterey, TN, the love of her life Chuck and loving daughter Amy Akstin Meads, Amy's husband Jordan Meads, and grandchildren Michael, Andrew, Abigail, Joseph and Merryn Meads of Tyler.
