



Patricia "Pat" Mary (Batchelor) Lindsey

August 29, 1938 - October 31, 2018

A celebration service to commemorate the life of Patricia Mary (Batchelor) Lindsey will be held on Saturday, November 3, 2018 at 2:00 p.m. in the chapel of Grace Community Church, 3215 Old Jacksonville Hwy. The family will receive friends in the foyer of the chapel after the service. She was born to Chester and Marie Batchelor on August 29, 1938 in Simms, Texas and passed from this life on October 31, 2018 at the age of 80 . She was graduated from Woodrow Wilson High School in Dallas. She married her high school sweetheart, Jerry Lindsey, in September 1957 and recently celebrated 61 years of marriage.

The Lindseys moved to Tyler with their three children in 1972 and Pat was a homemaker in her children's early years. Later, she worked for several educational institutions as a special education aide at Chapel Hill High School, as a library assistant at UT Tyler, and finally as a receptionist at Grace Community Elementary School.

Pat was a committed believer and an active member of Grace Community Church. Her church ministry began as a newlywed as she served, along with Jerry, in youth ministry in their church. In Tyler, she served as a leader in her Sunday school class, as mentor for young moms in both MOPS and Square One, led Bible studies and took part in mission trips. She also participated in BSF, regularly hosted their small group in their home , and found special pleasure in serving in camps for foster children including Royal Family Kids Camp and Teen Reach Adventure Camp.

Pat loved many things: travel that included numerous trips with grandchildren and with friends as well as frequent getaways with Jerry. She cherished spending time with her family. She loved the beach, the mountains, lovely sunsets, the blueberry patch, irises, birds that frequented her feeders, fresh veggies from their garden, and eating breakfast out. However, nothing energized Pat more than people! She was a total extrovert and loved the community that her large circle of friends provided her.

Survivors include: her loving husband, Jerry Lindsey; her daughter, Brenda Meadows (Kenneth); sons, Kevin Lindsey (Pam) and Kyle Lindsey (Wendy). She adored her six grandchildren: Heather Meadows Marshall (Matthew), Hope Meadows Kasrai (Ali), Kurt Lindsey (Laura), Camille Lindsey, Brooke Lindsey, Lauren Lindsey, and her five great-grandchildren: Mary-Meadows, Vivienne, and Harold Marshall, Evie and Aiden Lindsey and a sixth great-grandchild expected in November. She is also survived by her sister, Wanda Holcombe.
