Mr. Adkins, 97, of Emerald Bay, passed away Thursday, July 17, 2014 at Trinity Mother Frances Hospital in Tyler.

He was born October 17, 1916 in Loraine, Texas to Robert Lee and Laura Addie Whitten Atkins.

Mr. Adkins joined the military after graduating from high school and was a First Sergeant with the U. S. Army during WWII.
