Pasha passed away Wednesday, March 4, 2015 in Gresham.

He was born July 20, 1997 in Kyiv, Ukraine to Leonid and Olga Statsenko Zapolsky. Pasha is the oldest of four children and was a loving big brother. Pasha was known for being extremely intelligent, being wise beyond his years, caring to all, and always striving for success.

Pasha moved to Bullard, Texas in 2013 and became a student of The Brook Hill School. Pasha achieved all state academic honors and was a member of the Brook Hill tennis team and was a leader on the soccer team. Pasha's soccer brothers from Brook Hill will be honorary pallbearers.

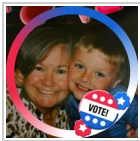

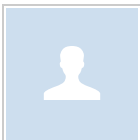
