“ LIVING LIFE IS STILL AN EFFORT

I am a different person now that my child died. It has been 4 months now since your death, and I find that my life is evolving. My basic personality is intact, most of my mind works well enough, but my perception of life, love, people has changed.

I'm a different person. Now I have to work at living my life. I now have to make myself do the things that I once took for granted-such as getting dressed and handling normal everyday responsibilities. I now make myself laugh at silly jokes, and I even have to force myself to listen to others. I am surprised when I laugh for no particular reason. I question myself as to "why has the joy of life disappeared?"

The loss of you is the most traumatic experience that a mother can NEVER understand. The tears won't stop, the memories overcome my every day life, and the struggle to go on sometimes overcomes my ability to cope. Yet, for the sake of the rest of my family, I choose to go on. I cherish the time I had with you, yet the pain I have now realizing that I will never see you get married, or be a grandmother to your children pains me. I do know that the only person that can understand this is a Mother. I carried you in my body for 9 months, and you became a part of my heart and soul. I now have a broken heart and that is something that will never be repaired. I have to learn to live with that. That is my goal. I have a family that needs me and I am struggling to gain the strength to go on. My faith is keeping me going these days. I sometimes wonder how anyone could go on without it. I have some sense of relief knowing that you are in a better place where no one can hurt you and you are only experiencing happiness. I love and miss you more than life can imagine, but knowing that you are at peace and have eternal joy- I would not bring you back even if I could. I know where you are and I know you are happy!

I have recently gone to a grieving workshop. I see parents who recently lost a child and the sorrow they are experiencing, and I ache for them. I also see parents that lost a child years ago and the

tears are also there. I understand now that my pain will never go away. It also will not ease with time. The only thing that might ease are the tears. These parents tell me that even after 9 years they cry every night. They just can control the tears in public. The holidays will never be the same again, the birthdays and the Mothers Days will be painful, but for the sake of the rest of my family, I choose to go on.

*Quinn, you brought me more joy than you can ever imagine. Remember our last conversation. I'll say it again. "Son, I'm proud of you".
