



Raima Lee Evans Wilson

March 8, 1917 - May 20, 2015

Memorial services for Raima Lee Smith Evans Wilson, 98, of Flint are scheduled for 3:30 p.m on Saturday, May 23, at Flint United Methodist Church with Rev. Royce Savage and Rev. Nathan “Buddy” Powell officiating under the direction of Stewart Family Funeral Home. Family will receive visitors following the service. A private burial will precede the service in the Flint Cemetery.

Mrs. Wilson passed away Wednesday, May 20, 2015 in Tyler. She was born on March 8, 1917 in Clayton, New Mexico, to Mary Gorda Morgan Smith and Goldwin McGratt Smith.

Raima Lee graduated from Gallatin High School in 1933, Jacksonville High School in 1934, and from Lon Morris College in 1936. She married Troy Evans in August, 1940, and they lived in Flint. Troy died in 1974 and in 1985 she married Willie Eldred Wilson of Flint.

Raima Lee was a homemaker and a clerk at the Flint Post Office. She was active in Flint United Methodist Church all of her adult life and was an officer in United Methodist Women and its predecessor organizations. She also was active in the Flint-Gresham Community Center organization, and served as an adult sponsor of 4-H, a treasurer of the Flint Cemetery association, and a lifetime member of Parent Teacher Association. Raima Lee and Willie Eldred volunteered for Meals on Wheels for many years.

Raima Lee was preceded in death by her parents, two husbands, and sisters Hattie Marie Smith Duke and Sallie Merle Smith Lane. She is survived by three daughters: Raima Isabel Evans Davis (Walt) of Commerce, Mary Ruth Evans Brown (Jim) of Jacksonville; and Sallie Elizabeth Evans (Randy Mallory) of Tyler. She is survived by six grandchildren and five great grandchildren and nieces and nephews. Her grandchildren will serve as pallbearers:

John Davis, Lee Davis, Troy Brown, Jeremiah Brown, Evan Mallory and Elissa Mallory. Honorary pallbearers are sons-in-laws, Walt Davis, Jim Brown, and Randy Mallory.
