Mr. Meadows passed away Sunday, January 25, 2015.

He was born September 2, 1961 in Sherman, Texas to Kirk and Barbara Hendrix Meadows.

Randy lived most of his life in Tyler. He was a graduate of Robert E. Lee High School and Tyler Junior College. He also graduated from Kilgore Police Academy going on to work for the Smith County Sheriff's Department in 1986. Randy moved up in rank attaining the positions of Sergeant of CID from 2006 to 2009 and Sergeant of the Narcotics Unit until retirement. He was selected as Smith County Plain Clothes Detective of the Year, East Texas Peace Officer Association's Narcotic Officer of the Year and Texas Narcotic Officer Association's Supervisor of the Year. Randy was a faithful Christian and attended Westwood Baptist Church. He enjoyed the outdoors including fishing, hunting, riding horses and farming.

He is survived by his loving family including his parents, Kirk and Barbara Meadows of Tyler; son, Joshua Meadows and wife Kelci of Bullard and their children, Briley and Hayes Meadows; fiancé, Amy Wright of Lindale.
