



## Ray Vanderpool

July 16, 1925 - March 1, 2007

Services for Ray L. Vanderpool, 81, of Tyler, will be held on Saturday, March 3, 2007 at 2:00 PM at Green Acres Baptist Church with Rev. officiating. Burial will follow in the Rose Hill Cemetery in Tyler under the direction of Stewart Family Funeral Home. Mr. Vanderpool passed away, Thursday, March 1, 2007 at the Trinity Mother Frances Hospital in Tyler. He was born July 16, 1925 in Dallas, Texas to the late Beulah and Milton Ray Vanderpool. Ray graduated Tyler High School in 1944 and attended Kemper Academy in Boonville, Missouri. He later went into the United States Navy where he attended Naval Officers Training and was medically discharged in 1945. Shortly after his discharge he began his career with Ideal Bakery Company of Tyler where he served with his father in all aspects of the company business and later became president. He also purchased Sun Beam Bakery in San Antonio in 1967. After his retirement in 1974 he devoted himself to his passions: his churches, various ministries, and evangelism. The church and the Lord were two of the most important parts of his life. Ray was one of the founders of Grace Community Church and was a member of the Kiwanis Club of Tyler. However, the most significant occurrence in his life was when he became a Christian in 1960. Mr. Vanderpool was preceded in death by his parents; sister, Joan Vanderpool Boring; and his first wife, Patricia Ann (Ware) Vanderpool. Ray is survived by his loving family including his wife of 12 years, Barbara Vanderpool of Tyler; daughters, Vici Vanderpool of Dallas, Jan Stark and husband Bubba of Austin; sons, Milton Vanderpool and wife Cathy of
