Mr. Stephenson passed away Thursday, February 9, 2017 in Conroe.

He was born November 16, 1939 in Bartlesville, Oklahoma to Raymond Everett Stephenson, Sr. and Edna Loyd McCollum Stephenson.

Ray grew up in the Texas Panhandle, graduated from Pampa High School in 1958, and served as co-captain of the 1958 Harvester State 4A Championship Basketball Team.

He worked for 55 years in construction of pipelines and related facilities in the oil and gas industry in over 15 states across the US, including Alaska, New York, Florida, California, Wyoming, Kansas, and Nebraska.

Ray was a member of the First Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) of Pampa, Texas.

He was preceded in death by his father, mother and sister, June Field.

He is survived by his loving family, including wife Janet of Bullard; daughter, Stacey Parker of Houston; step-daughters, Dawn Edwards of Plano and Shannon Hyatt of Austin; brother, Jim Stephenson of Lubbock; and four grandchildren.

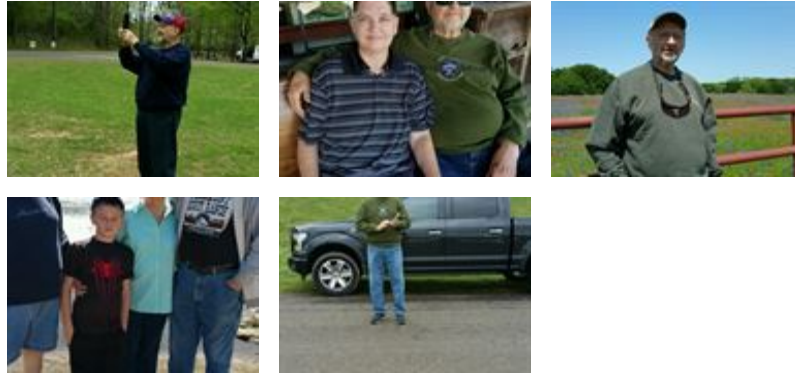
