Reta B. Smith, 93, of Flint, Texas passed away peacefully on February 5, 2017 in Tyler, Texas. She was married for over 70 years to Albert W. Smith (deceased in April 2015). She is survived by her twin sister, Ruth Welch; four sons, Gary Smith and partner Ann Chadwick, Jerry Smith and wife Ruth, Dana Smith and wife Cheryl, and Al Smith, Jr. and wife Shirley; 4 grandchildren; and 13 great-grandchildren.

She and Dad were married in Oklahoma City in October 1944 after a 2 ½ month courtship. During her lifetime she and the family lived in many different places before retiring in Flint, Texas. She attended Harvest Time Full Gospel Church in Flint, Texas.
